Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill three (3) vacant positions of Regulator, Financial Services Commission, Anguilla.

The Financial Services Commission is a statutory body formed pursuant to the Financial Services Commission Act, 2003. Its main functions are to license and regulate financial services business in and from within Anguilla.

The functions of the position include, but are not limited to the following: reviewing and processing applications for regulatory approvals and licenses; monitoring and evaluating regulated sectors; conducting onsite inspections of licensees; monitoring compliance with applicable legislation; and maintaining a database of statistics on assigned licensees.

The successful candidate will need to have:

- a first degree or professional qualification in accounting, finance, economics, business, banking, computer science, insurance or law.
- Knowledge of current international financial services regulatory standards and practices.
- Competence using relevant financial software and analytical tools.

Regulatory training and experience and/or relevant post-graduate qualifications would be an asset.
