Deputy Director and Regulators

Anguilla Financial Services Commission

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill one Deputy Director and three Regulator positions at the Anguilla Financial Services Commission.

The Financial Services Commission is a statutory body formed pursuant to the Financial Services Commission Act, 2003. Its main functions are to license and regulate financial services business in and from Anguilla.

Deputy Director: The functions include, but are not limited to the following: supervising staff; advising on policies and legislation; administering the financial services enactments; recommending on the licensing of financial institutions; supervising/regulating financial institutions; and representing the Commission in Anguilla and overseas. The successful candidate will report to the Director.

The successful candidate should have:

- Professional and/or academic qualification(s) in a financial services related discipline, such as, accounting, economics, banking, insurance, finance, law, etc, and/or at least three years experience in the financial services industry. Post graduate qualification(s) would be an asset.
- Knowledge of current international standards and practices, which apply to the regulation of financial services.
- Strong leadership skills.

Regulators: The functions include, but are not limited to the following: processing applications for licences and other regulatory approvals; supervising a portfolio of institutions, conducting onsite inspections of licensees; monitoring compliance with applicable legislation; and maintaining a database of statistics on assigned licensees.

The successful candidate should have:

- Professional and/or qualification(s) in a financial services related discipline, such as, accounting, economics, banking, insurance, finance, law, etc. Knowledge of current international standards and practices, which apply to the regulation of financial services, would be an asset.
