

Revised Regulations of Anguilla: P98-3

PROCEEDS OF CRIME ACT (R.S.A. c. P98)**PROCEEDS OF CRIME (TRANSITIONAL) REGULATIONS**

Note: These Regulations are enabled under section 167(2) of the Proceeds of Crime Act, R.S.A. c. P98.

Registration of Service Providers

1. (1) A person who, immediately before 16 July 2009, was a service provider to whom section 152 of the Act applies, does not contravene section 152 and is not guilty of an offence under section 152(3) by carrying on a relevant business in or from Anguilla whilst not registered with the relevant supervisory authority from 16 July 2009 to—

- (a) 17 January 2010; or
- (b) the date that the person's application for registration is determined, if the person applies for registration from 14 September 2009 to 17 January 2010.

(2) A person who, at any time from 14 September 2009 to 16 October 2009, becomes a service provider to whom section 152 of the Act applies, does not contravene section 152 and is not guilty of an offence under section 152(3) by carrying on a relevant business in or from Anguilla whilst not registered with the relevant supervisory authority from 16 July 2009 to—

- (a) 19 October 2009; or
- (b) the date that the person's application for registration is determined, if the person applies for registration from 14 September 2009 to 16 October 2009.
