Broker Option

The Anguilla Financial Services Commission (the “Commission”) is informing the public that Broker Option (a.k.a. BrokerOption, Brokeroption and brokeroption) is not licensed, nor has it ever been licensed, by the Commission to carry on business or manage or administer their affairs in or from within Anguilla.

A website for Broker Option includes an address in Anguilla. The address is that of two licensed company managers. The Commission has confirmed that the company managers have no knowledge of, or professional relationship with, Broker Option.

Further, the Commission has determined that the Anguilla Commercial Registry has no record of Broker Option.
