ACCOUNTANT – FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill the post of Accountant with the Financial Services Commission ("the Commission"). The primary function and purpose of the post is the accounting and financial management of the Commission. The post is senior and reports to the Director of the Financial Services Commission.

The primary duties of the post include:

- Maintain and manage the Commission's financial records, including monthly reconciliation of all bank accounts, the preparation of monthly management accounts for the Director and quarterly management accounts for the Board, and the coordination of the annual audit of the Commission accounts;
- Preparation and maintenance of budgets, forecasts and written procedures for internal payment systems, accounting system and accounting databases;
- Administer the Commission's budget in accordance with established procedures;
- Assist the Director with the administration of the Commission; including assisting with the
 preparation of the Commission's budget, work programme and strategic plan, and
 advising on operating policies, manpower and material requirements for the efficient
 operation of the Commission.
- Provide administrative and accounting support to Director and the Commission based on a sound knowledge of contemporary best practices in these areas;
