Senior Regulator, Financial Services Commission

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill one (1) vacant position of Senior Regulator, at the Financial Services Commission, Anguilla

The functions of the position include, but are not limited to the following:

- regulating, supervising and/or administration of insurance licensees and providing support in the supervision of credit union and other licensees as assigned;
- reviewing and processing applications for regulatory approvals and licenses;
- monitoring compliance with applicable legislation;
- monitoring and conducting ongoing analysis of assigned institutions to ascertain, at a minimum, their viability, liquidity and solvency;
- identifying and reporting on developing financial problems in assigned institutions;
- planning, coordinating, leading and participating in onsite inspections of insurance licensees;
- preparing and reviewing inspection reports and remedial action documents
- conducting due diligence on relevant persons and entities;
- supervising and reviewing the work of direct reports;
- providing training in areas of expertise.

The successful candidate will need to have:

- A first degree or professional qualification preferably in insurance, finance, accounting, business, banking or economics. Applicants with a first degree or professional qualification in other fields such as law or compliance will also be considered.
- At least 5 years' experience working in an insurance, finance, regulatory or compliance job/environment.
- Knowledge of current international financial services regulatory standards and practices, particularly insurance.
- Relevant post-graduate certifications, designations or qualifications in the area of insurance and/or regulation would be an asset.
- Ability to read and understand legislation would also be an asset
