Consultation Note:

The [DRAFT] Registrar of Companies (Compliance Measures) Bill

The Anguilla Financial Services Commission (“AFSC”) has issued the [DRAFT] **Registrar of Companies (Compliance Measures) Bill (“the Bill”)** for the FINAL consultation period.

The [DRAFT] **Registrar of Companies (Compliance Measures) Bill (“the Bill”)** is a standalone piece of legislation that empowers the Registrar of Companies to:

- Conduct site visits and inspections of registered entities;
- Require the production of documents and records;
- Issue notices to comply with statutory obligations; and
- Impose civil penalties for non-compliance.

The Bill introduces critical supervisory and enforcement tools designed to enhance regulatory oversight, support Anguilla's international obligations and commitments, and mirror international best practices in Registry supervision.
