The Anguilla Financial Services Commission (“AFSC”) is inviting quotations from qualified legal experts, legislative drafters, or legal consortia to lead the development of a modern, internationally credible insolvency framework for Anguilla. SCOPE OF WORKS

This pivotal project aims to enhance market confidence and legal certainty by introducing efficient corporate restructuring and business rescue mechanisms alongside streamlined liquidation and bankruptcy procedures. The selected expert will design a comprehensive statutory regime that equitably balances stakeholder interests, establishes licensing and supervisory standards for insolvency practitioners, and modernises public administration through a fit-for-purpose Official Receiver function. Additionally, the framework will integrate advanced cross-border insolvency tools to support effective multinational asset recovery, aligning Anguilla’s regime with international best practices while tailoring solutions to the jurisdiction's unique legal and economic landscape. KEY DELIVERABLES

The expert will be required to deliver an inception report, a comparative legal review of insolvency frameworks, a gap analysis with policy recommendations, and a comprehensive policy



framework paper. These key outputs must be provided according to an agreed-upon work plan and timeline.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

Experts must be qualified legal professionals in a common law jurisdiction with at least ten years of legislative drafting experience, specifically in offshore or Commonwealth environments. They must possess expertise in insolvency, financial services regulation, and the ability to draft clear, enforceable instruments for government or regulatory clients.
